# OUR INSTITUTION

Captain Williamson Sangma State University (CWSSU) has been established by an Act of the Government of Meghalaya in 2011. Fully funded by the Government of Meghalaya, this institute of higher learning has also obtained due recognition of the University Grants Commission under section 2f of the UGC Act, 1956. Aiming to impart quality education to the aspirants of higher learning in the state of Meghalaya and beyond, this University with its sprawling main campus is now coming up at a lovely natural setting amidst enchanting greenery at Tura, Balalgre. The University is also striving/taking steps to establish an appropriate second campus at Shillong, East Khasi Hills. As the first ever State University of Meghalaya and the second affiliating University in the State, it is set to cater to the growing demands for quality higher education amongst the youths of the State and its neighbourhood in India's North East region.

Being a newly founded University and with much of its infrastructure facilities at main campus being still under construction, the CWSSU intends to have a modest beginning this year with fourteen of its academic departments of humanities, social sciences and language studies opening up for admission of the first batch of post graduate students with its academic departments suitably distributed at its two campuses.

The University has already initiated steps for establishing at least six science departments and has also recruited the faculty for teaching in these departments and the classes will commence with actual teaching of the Master's programme in science at its campus with effect from the 2026-27 academic session in order to enable the University have the time space to build its state-of-the-art laboratories and library facilities at its campus.

With an enthusiastic, committed and dedicated teaching faculty already in place to carry forward the mission and vision of the University, there is an assurance of the tremendous potential it holds in addressing the modern day higher educational needs of the youths of this tiny salubrious State in particular and the entire north eastern region of India in general. The faculty of this University, composed of a reasonably balanced blend of youth and experience overrides the current infrastructure deficits in a campus under construction, and is an assurance for a promising start of its academic journey.
